

CLARKSTON AREA OPTIMIST CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATIONS MUST BE EMAILED TO

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BY 6:00 pm - MARCH 17, 2023

Eligibility: Any graduating high school senior residing in the Clarkston Community Schools attendance area, intending to continue their education in a 2 or 4 year college or university program, or a trade school. Public school, private school and home school seniors are eligible.

Four scholarships will be awarded this year in the amount of \$3,000 each:

1. The Andrea Schroeder Scholarship for the Fine Arts
2. The Henry Richardson Friend of Youth Scholarship
3. The James A. Evans Scholarship
4. Making Your Optimism Come True Scholarship. (This scholarship is particularly intended for students who want to go on to a trade school, major in a trade such as construction management at a college or use the scholarship to purchase tools/equipment to use in the trades→proof of employment will be required.)

Criteria:

1. Live the Optimist Creed
2. Volunteers in programs which benefit youth
3. Involvement in extra-curricular activities

You Must Provide the following:

1. **Form 1:** General Information (attached)
2. **Form 2:** Activities & Accomplishments (attached)
3. **Essay:** Please tell us about a volunteer service or work experience that you have performed and what you learned from it. You may write about it from one of the following perspectives:
 - a. impacted your career choices, OR
 - b. contributed to our community

NOTE: Essays should be no longer than two pages, double spaced, one inch margins, using a 12 point font. The Essay should have a title and use appropriate grammar and punctuation.

4. **One Letter of Recommendation.** These letters should come from non-family members such as: teacher, counselor, principal, employer, coach, Scout leader, Clergy member, etc.
5. For **the** person who recommended you, please briefly describe, in **one paragraph**, how this person has influenced you or how they have made a difference in your life.
6. **Form 3:** Release Information (attached)
